

Dataset Contributions to the B# SDG Scorecard Program

The Bluenumber Foundation welcomes voluntary contributions of SDG related datasets to any ongoing projects under the B# SDG Scorecard Program. Datasets would need to be reviewed through a consultation process to determine their suitability. Organisations that have successfully contributed their datasets will be credited and provided with a map of their datapoints. All data contributions require the prior informed consent of individuals to whom the data belongs.

1. Why should you contribute your dataset?

If you are servicing a population that you believe could benefit from being part of the SDG Scorecard program, contributing your dataset to the SDG Scorecard program will allow us to build a comprehensive and reliable source for gap and progress analyses. This will create opportunities to develop targeted solutions for individuals and organizations involved with said population. It will also allow the mapping of individuals in your dataset.

2. What happens if you contribute your dataset?

If you have information relevant to sustainable developmental goals for your beneficiary population, we will be able to carry out a data match report and following that, score said population on SDGs that meet the minimum requirement threshold based on a pre-determined internal standard. We will keep you updated on the process throughout.

3. What can we share with you?

We will be able to provide aggregate reports and analyses of populations that have participated with the SDG Scorecard Program to allow you to tailor solutions relevant to these gaps. Your dataset will also be mapped and every individual assigned a B# ID.
